The platform is integrated with internal booking systems, calendars, facility management systems and various IoT sensors that register occupancy of desks and meeting rooms.

The deep integration of MapsIndoors to LinkedIn's internal systems and live sensor data are expected to add great value to their office spaces worldwide."
